A Note on Black History

JACKIE ROBINSON, BASEBALL GREAT

This is the 70th anniversary of the sports legend, Jackie Robinson, who paved the path to integration of Baseball. He was already known as a man of principle when he joined the Brooklyn Dodgers on April 10, 1947. Jackie Robinson was UCLA's first four-letter athlete in baseball, track, football and basketball. He then made a name for himself in the Negro Leagues with the Kansas City Monarchs. While on the road with the Monarchs, he established the precedent of asking to use the rest rooms before buying gas, no access to rest room, then, no gas bought. His wife Rachel was impressed when she first met him. She said, "Jack walked straight. He held his head up and he was proud of not just his color, but his people."
